WHO CAN USE TRAVEL MEDICINE?



TRICARE beneficiaries



Retired service members



Dependents accompanying Soldiers on PCS orders



Active-Duty Soldiers traveling internationally while on leave



IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Active-Duty Soldiers traveling on PCS or TDY orders must process through the Soldier Readiness Center (SRC).



DHA and Department of the Army civilian employees must process through Occupational Health, if traveling for occupational purposes.



SOME COUNTRIES REQUIRE COMPLETED IMMUNIZATIONS PRIOR TO ENTRY.

Some countries may deny entry if required vaccinations are not completed before travel. It is your responsibility to ensure all required vaccinations are completed in time for your destination. Travel Medicine can help you meet these requirements.



DON'T WAIT!

Schedule your appointment at least 4–6 weeks before departure to allow time for:



Required vaccinations



Destination-specific health recommendations



Travel medications



Disease prevention counseling

Some vaccines require multiple doses and time to become fully effective.
